Excellian non-interfaced charges resource



There are some occasions where charges for laboratory testing referred to Allina Health Laboratory will not cross the interface, and thus not post automatically on HARs. Charges that are not interfaced have an accession in the client portal, or on the client notification, that starts with RQ or B. These accessions should be reviewed and the corresponding charges posted manually.

- RQ is a charge to a non-interfaced test.
- B signifies a reflex or additional charge that needs to be manually posted.

Accession ID's beginning with C or AC will file automatically, and would not require review.

Below is an example of the information included on a Notification spreadsheet.
