MICROBIOLOGY

RSV, Rapid Antigen

Quick reference

Effective October 1, 2022, the RSV, Rapid Antigen assay (6533A/LAB6533A) will no longer be performed at Allina Health Laboratory.

Details

Allina Health Laboratory has validated instrumentation to increase capacity for COVID and Influenza PCR testing at all hospital sites. RSV PCR testing is available with results available less than 24 hours from receipt at the performing laboratory.

- The Pediatric COVID/Flu/RSV Panel (14423/LAB14423) is restricted to children <6 years old who do not require hospitalization.
- The RSV by NAAT (14483/LAB14483) is available without age restriction, also, to those
 not requiring hospitalization. To note, if testing for COVID plus Influenza and/or RSV is
 needed, two (2) separate NP swabs are required. One for COVID/FLU and one for RSV.
- Respiratory Panel Multiplex PCR (12653/LAB12653) test remains available for emergency department/observation patients, in-patients, and high-risk outpatients (immunocompromised or underlying cardiac/lung conditions) presenting with signs and symptoms of acute respiratory illness.

Enterovirus RNA PCR, CSF

Quick reference

Effective September 6, 2022 the Enterovirus RNC PCR, CSF assay was discontinued.

Details

The suggested alternative is the Meningitis/Encephalitis (ME) pathogen multiplex PCR, CSF (14504/LAB14504), performed at Allina Health Laboratory. The ME multiplex PCR, CSF assay uses rapid detection for the six most common viruses causing encephalitis, including Enterorus.

REFERRAL TESTING

Kidney stone urine saturation

Quick reference

Effective September 26, 2022, the <u>Kidney stone urine/saturation 13502/LAB13502</u> assay will require new specimen requirements.

Details

The use of a <u>Kidney stone urine saturation collection kit</u> will be used to collect, process and freeze the sample before sending to LabCorp. This kit is currently available through the supply catalog.

Ganglioside antibodies

SUPPLIES

6N HCL 24-hr urine container shortage

Quick reference

Due to a severe shortage of the 6N HCL 24-hour urine collection jugs, all sites will need to limit the use of this supply by using alternate collection containers when indicated. Alternate collection alerts are in the Allina Health Laboratory Test Catalog.

When reviewing orders for 24-hour urine collection, and the preferred collection indicates 6N HCL, please provide the alternate acceptable preservative.

Exception: The following assays indicate no other alternative to 6N HCL. Guidance for alternate testing is provided below. Orders received at an Allina facility for these affected assays will be cancelled and faxed communication follow up will be sent to the provider.

Urine catecholamines should be reserved for auxiliary testing when plasma and urine metanephrine results do not exclude pheochromocytoma. If this is the indication, please contact Client Services at (612) 863-4678.

SUPPLIES

Metal free tube supply

Quick reference

The national supply chain of metal free tubes continues to be strained. However, Allina Health Laboratory has obtained slightly more inventory and will transition from fixed allocation to fulfillment through the Allina Health Supply Catalog.

Details

All conservation efforts remain in place:

- Utilizing all tubes right up until expiration date and reallocating supply throughout the system
- Deferring non-critical testing that can be delayed until additional tube supply can be obtained.
- Utilizing alternative blood collection tube containers whenever possible.
- Best practice restrictions are still in place for zinc, copper, and selenium test orders.

When additional supply of Navy Blue Metal Free EDTA, Navy Blue No Additive, and Tan metal free K2EDTA blood collection tubes is needed:

- Submit a request through the AHL Supply catalog for (5) five or less
- Orders for greater than (5) five will not be honored.
- Monthly allocations will no longer be sent.

Continue to collect zinc, selenium, and copper in Navy top tubes.
