Re: COVID-19 testing updates

Please continue to refer to the <u>MDH</u>, Wisconsin <u>DHS</u> or <u>CDC</u> websites for the most current information available.

Supplies:

- Allina Health Laboratory will offer COVID-19/Coronavirus sample collection kits for this testing. These kits can be found by searching "Covid" in the supply catalog.
- Due to the continued shortage of supplies, as you place supply orders, you may receive various collection kits. All are acceptable to use for any of the sites you are sending to. Collection kits may have a sticker on them indicating OP or NP swabs and some kits may contain two swabs. Only one swab is needed for testing; the 2nd can be discarded.





- Sites should order minimal volumes for your sample collection needs, as shortages still exist, and supplies
 must be dispersed to all collection sites, both Allina Health and Affiliate. The supplies you receive may
 vary but be assured you will receive what is needed for testing at the sites you are sending to.
- In our meetings, there were questions raised on the acceptable specimens. Since the information is ever
 changing, please refer to test catalog on our website. However, if the LabCorp, Mayo or MDH sites have
 a specific specimen type listed that we have not indicated, you are welcome to send it to us and we will
 send it on for testing.

Test catalog:

• The AHL Test catalog has the correct collection information, however, because the testing is ever changing, the orderable test information included below is not in the test catalog. The order that is listed is the test code for Allina Health facilities (*please do not order using this Allina collection code*). We are looking at options to add the tests below as well at some point.



Test/Result Information:


- COVID 19 LabCorp (LAB14303)
 - Orders you are directing to LabCorp should be packing listed to the central lab
 - ♦ To expedite handling at the AHL central lab, packing list and package these Covid samples separately from your other sendout samples
 - Results for this test will come via interface to Excellian
 - Result routing will follow the current result routing at your facility
 - Current cost of this test is \$56.30
 - ♦ Turnaround time is 1-4 days based on when the specimen is received at LabCorp and their volumes.
 - * Specimens indicated as priority one will be run first.
 - LabCorp courier times at the central lab are: Ready at 6pm for first flight and ready by 8pm for last flight
 - MDH forms do not need to be sent with this test. All needed information for reporting the MDH or WISLH will be sent through the interface and reported to MDH and WISLH

COVID19 Mayo 2 (LAB14334)

- ♦ There are order level questions that must be answered
- Orders you are directing to Mayo should be packing listed to the central lab
- ♦ To expedite handling at the AHL central lab, packing list and package these Covid samples separately from your other sendout samples
- Results for this test will come via interface to Excellian
- Result routing will follow the current result routing at your facility
- Current cost of this test is \$107
- - Mayo courier pickup times at the central lab are: Monday Friday 10:30am and
 7:30pm; Saturday 4:50pm and Sunday/holidays at 4:30pm
- MDH forms do not need to be sent with this test. All needed information for reporting the MDH or WISLH will be sent through the interface and reported to MDH and WDH

COVID 19 MDH/WSLH Aff (LAB14304)

- ♦ To be used in place of an MSO (LAB994) when sending samples to MDH or WISLH
- The samples for MDH must be packaged as a pass through, but can still be sent with your regular Allina Health scheduled couriers
- MDH paperwork must accompany these specimens
- Your site will be able to result this test
- ♦ Your site will need to scan the reports into this new orderable test, as it is not interfaced
- Testing restricted to Restricted to pts in dialysis centers, congregated living settings
- Turnaround time is 24-48 hours based on when specimen is received at MDH.
- MDH courier pick up times at the central lab are: Monday-Friday 9:15am; Saturday 7:45-8:45am

Additional Information:

- LabCorp and Mayo will both report these test results to the state departments
- All canceled tests will be called to your site
- Effective 6/5/20: Positive test results will no longer be called to your site as they are not considered a critical result, and are no longer being called to Allina Health Laboratory by our referral labs.
- Tracking Covid-19 results:
 - There is no specific report for this tracking. If tracking is needed, an LIS ticket will be needed to request a report for your site.


Question have been updated to allow a cascading workflow based on the answer to the question below.
