How to Schedule a Fine Needle Aspirate (FNA)





RADIOLOGY:

Schedule with Radiology;

- For In-patients, order an FNA in Excellian (LAB6301)
- Radiology will order the FNA for Out-Patients.

A Cytotechnologist or Pathologist will perform (as requested) STAT adequacy and collect the specimen for Cytology *

* If no STAT adequacy is performed and Core Biopsies are obtained (no slides are made and stained during the process), the specimen should be ordered in Excellian as a Path Tissue Exam.

Separate specimen should be sent to Microbiology as needed.

SUPERFICIAL:

To schedule a superficial fine needle aspiration *performed by a pathologist*, contact the following department as needed:

An FNA order will need to be placed at the time of the procedure.

- For hospital providers, order in Excellian (LAB6301).
- Providers referring patients from outside hospitals or clinics must fax an order (completed Allina Health Laboratory FNA requisition or prescription pad request) to the performing hospital Cytology/Pathology laboratory.
